- Firewise Plant
- North American Native
- USDA Zone: 2-8
- Best for Fall Color: Center Glow

Fothergilla gardenii

- Deciduous Shrub
- Size: 3' to 4' tall
- Round to upright oval
- Multi-stemmed/compact
- Year Round interest
- Fall color
- Attracts Birds
- Deer Resistant
- Easy Care
- North American Native
- USDA Zone: 5-9





Heavenly Bamboo (Nadina)



- Evergreen shrub
- Size: 30 inches
- Leaves turn fiery crimson in the winter
- Plant in Full Sun for Color
- Firewise Plant
- USDA Zones: 4-10
- Best For Fall Color: Firepower

Witch Hazel (Corylopsis)



- Deciduous shrub,
- Plant in full sun or part shade, protect from wind
- Slow growing 8 to 20 feet tall, and as wide
- Fragrant flowers born on bare branches
- Brilliant Fall color
- USDA Zones: 4-8

- Blueberry (Vaccinium spp.) Full Sun/ Part Shade; USDA Zones: 5-10
- Strawberries (Fragaria) Full Sun USDA Zones: 3-10
- Smoketree (Cotinus coggygria) Full Sun; Height 10-15 ft; USDA Zones: 5-8
- Red or Yellow Twig Dogwood (Cornus spp.) Sun/Part Shade; USDA Zones: 2-9
- Gingko (G. biloba)- Full Sun; Height slow 80ft; USDA Zones: 4-9
- 'Forest Pansy' Redbud (C. canadensis) Sun/Light shade; Height 20 ft; USDA Zones: 4-9
- Maples (acer spp.)

Red Maples (*Acer rubrum* spp.) – Height: 35- 50 ft Sugar maple (*A. saccharum*) – Height: 80-115 ft (ex-large tree)

Vine maple (A. circinatum) – Height: 12-15 ft Japanese maple (A. palmatum) Height: 6 – 20 ft
